

**Discussion Summary of Working Group IV**  
**Emergency Management**

TECRO-AIT Meeting of Joint Standing Committee on Civil Nuclear Cooperation  
December 8-9, 2015

1. There are 4 items in group IV originally, one item (AE-DE-F39:Nuclear Forensics Initiative) in group III move into group IV. Both sides agree to keep ongoing these 5 items.
2. Commitments
  - a). NNSA will invite AEC representatives to observe the emergency preparation for the Super Bowl in 2016 & 2017.
  - b). NNSA may continue to invite AEC to attend the 2016 Annual EMI-SIG Meeting on May 2-6, 2016.
  - c). NNSA and AEC will continue to evaluate and update SOI work plan in 2016.
  - d). NNSA may conduct an Advanced I-CM course in Taiwan tentatively in 2016.
  - e). NNSA may help AEC arrange a local I-RAPTER-MPE training course for a major public event. Some of trainees will be future trainers.
  - f). AEC will invite NNSA representatives to observe the 2016 nuclear emergency exercise to be held in September at Maanshan Nuclear Power Plant in southern Taiwan.
  - g). To establish the mobile labs for nuclear emergency management, AEC will provide more details, so NNSA can start gathering information related to it.
  - h). NNSA will invite AEC to attend 2016 I-AMS events in Las Vegas, including: (1) Advanced SPARCS/AVID training on April 4-8; (2) I-AMS Technical Exchange on alternative aerial platforms including UAV/UAS on April 11-15.
  - i). NNSA may conduct a mission-planning training (trainees include helicopter pilot) on steering and technical data interpretation in Taiwan tentatively in 2016.
  - j). AEC will continue to jointly engage in activities with NNSA to strengthen emergency management and response to nuclear events.
