**D59:** If NRC plans to hold any training program related to radiation protection aspect of decommissioning, please notify NSC in advance. NSC would send staff to attend it if budget allows.

**D64:** NSC will inform NRC on specific topics they are interested in, and NRC will send course information.

- 17: NARI will send a short summary proposal to AIT to identify the proper contacts. (WG #3 agreed to merge I7 and I14, and title changed to Technical Exchange and Information Sharing on Radiopharmaceuticals)
- **119:** NARI plans to decide on participation in the IEEE Nuclear Science Symposium and Medical Imaging Conference to be held in Tampa, USA in 2024 based on actual circumstances.
