- AE-DE-F28, "Atmospheric Plume Modeling"
 - 3. AEC requests a plume model workshop. (AEC propose to have technical exchange with DOE/NNSA experts on NARAC modeling for RDD scenario.)

 - 4. AEC's Nuclear Safety Duty Center will continue to make communication tests through fax and email with DOE/NNSA's Forrestal Watch Office every six months.
