Two Deputy Atomic Ministers Appointed In Taiwan

Two new deputy ministers – Shian-Jang Su and Chao-Yie Yang – were appointed to Taiwan's Atomic Energy Council (AEC) this month as the result of recent cabinet changes.

Dr Su, 59, is a former director of the AEC's Department of Radiation Protection who received his doctorate in nuclear engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology in the US. He joined the AEC in 2002 and is a former head of the Health Physics Division at Taiwan's Institute of Nuclear Energy Research (INER) and an associate professor at the National Tsing-Hua University.

Dr Yang, 61, was the director-general of INER for the past two years and a former head of the INER's Nuclear Safety Division and executive secretary of the Nuclear Safety Committee. He received his doctorate in nuclear engineering from the University of Washington in the US and has worked at INER for more than 30 years.
