

Discussion Summary of Working Group I
Matters Pertaining to Reactor Regulation and Regulatory Research

Working Group I began this year's meeting with 20 existing items. After three presentations and extensive working group discussions, the NRC and AEC agreed that an item on "Information Exchange on Nuclear Reactor Power Uprate Safety Review" was successfully completed, and will be closed. As such, working Group I has 19 items of mutual cooperation ongoing. The next AEC/NRC bilateral technical meeting will be held in Taipei in 2016, and both sides will discuss on the exact dates in the coming months.

Commitments

1. NRC and AEC will cooperate on renewal of CSARP agreement for 2016-2021, and will continue negotiating in 2016. Annual billing will be provided by NRC to AEC after renewing the agreement.
2. NRC and AEC will continue negotiating on RAMP agreement in 2016, and TECRO will pay the first annual membership fee upon completion of the RAMP agreement.
3. NRC and AEC will cooperate on renewal of CAMP agreement for 2016-2021, and will continue negotiating in 2016. Annual billing will be provided by NRC to AEC after renewing the agreement.
4. NRC and AEC will continue negotiating on SACADA agreement in 2016. After signing the SACADA agreement, there will be sequence of activities conducted by NRC/RES and AEC/TPC staff.
5. INER would like to attend the Fire PRA workshops held by NRC and EPRI in Washington, DC and Charlotte, NC in 2016. NRC will provide information on the workshop to INER in future communications.
6. AEC will share with NRC the information of the CNS report progress during the 2016 BTM meeting.
7. NRC will share with AEC the NRC 2016 inspector training course list and AEC may send two staff members to attend the training course and visit NRC in 2016.
8. NRC will share with AEC the updated information on GSI-191 (PWR & BWR) and GSI-193 (BWR) during the 2016 BTM meeting.
9. AEC and NRC will continue exchanging information on post-Fukushima related regulatory activities during the RIC, and BTM meetings in 2016.
10. AEC will share with NRC on Chinshan license renewal information in 2016.

11. NRC agrees to share the information, upon AEC's request, of the operational readiness inspections of Watts Bar Unit 2 during the 2016 BTM meeting.
12. AEC will keep NRC informed on the status of Lungmen NPP in 2016.
