Reportable Event Reports (RERs)

The NSC, by referring to U.S.NRC Regulations Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations 50.73, published the “Guideline for Reportable Events of Nuclear Power Plants” in 1988. The further related “Regulation for Reportable Events and Immediate Notification of Nuclear Reactor Facilities” was promulgated by the NSC in 2004.

This regulation stipulates that the licensee must issue a prompt notification to the NSC regarding events that either require further investigations or arouse public concerns. These events include: scrams, forced shutdowns for equipment maintenance, safety system malfunctions, the activation of safety systems, industrial safety events; etc. A detailed event report must be submitted to the NSC within 30 days after the occurrence of the event.
