In reference to paragraph 1 of Article 15 of the Agreement for Cooperation Between the American Institute in Taiwan and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in the United States Concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy, done at Washington December 20, 2013 ("the AIT-TECRO Agreement"), I have the honor to inform you that AIT and the authorities it represents have completed all applicable requirements for entry into force of the AIT-TECRO Agreement. Following AIT receipt on or prior to June 22, 2014, of a response letter from TECRO stating that TECRO and the authorities it represents have completed all applicable requirements for entry into force of the AIT-TECRO Agreement, pursuant to paragraph 1 of Article 15 of the AIT-TECRO Agreement, the AIT-TECRO Agreement shall enter into force on June 22, 2014, the date of expiration of the Agreement for Cooperation between the Government of the United States of America and the Government of the Republic of China Concerning the Civil Uses of Atomic Energy, signed on April 4, 1972, as amended and extended.
